Bring on March 3—the date of competition.

YOU MUST SUBMIT YOUR FINAL TEAM ROSTER (enclosed) AND AN INSURANCE COVERAGE FORM (enclosed), BOTH SIGNED BY SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS. Be sure to do this before Friday, March 3. MAKE SURE YOUR SCHOOL HAS APPROVED THIS EVENT AS A FIELD TRIP.

1. **Bring your final registration** and your **Insurance Coverage** form with you. **IF YOU OWE US MONEY—BRING A CHECK OR YOU MAY NOT COMPETE.**
2. Registration will not open until about 8:00. OUR HEADQUARTERS WILL BE IN **XX**(see map). Coaches only register teams and can pick up team packets. Proctors for events can pick up their packets at the same location.
3. **PARKING:** please use the appropriate spaces. We will give you directions as you arrive. We will pay for parking at UCR
4. Please bring as many volunteers as possible. If you bring extra students, please let them be runners. Please go into buildings as designated for events. You will be assigned to **Arbitration** for 1 hour sometime during the day.
5. Bring food, but we will have food on the campus. Also please bring some bags for students to help clean up.
6. In case of rain, we will try to make use of the hallways in our enclosed buildings. The parking lots are not that far away to return team materials to secure places. Encourage your teams to keep the campus in the same shape it was when we all arrived.
7. T-shirts may NOT use any version of the Olympics design. You may not have circles or hexagons as part of the logo. The letters SO or Science Olympiad may be used. You may NOT use Olympiad without the word science before it.

Room Assignments. We hope that our schedule will not change. Our final schedule will be in the packets you pick up when you turn in your team rosters. For self-scheduling events: teams will schedule their time for events at the room where they impound their devices. **For the Helicopters, we will share the information later.**

Have your kids ready for any possible weather. I hope that everything is as wonderful as today. **Please have a student come back to headquarters and tell us where your team assembly area is in case someone needs to contact the team.**

SCIENCE OLYMPIAD CODE OF CONDUCT
